



# Information Sheet - Building Heating

## How is the building heated?

- For heating the fresh air which is circulated through the common element hallways and stairwells in the winter, the building has three electric heaters located on the roof.
- In unit heat is provided by electric base board heaters which are controlled by your thermostats.

## When does the heat get turned on in the common elements in the fall?

- Usually it is around the end of October, but this can change depending on the weather.
- We try to make sure that the building common elements can maintain the generally accepted room temperature of 20°C (68°F). However if an outdoor temperature spike or drop occurs after we've made the switch, it is possible that we will be unable to maintain this range. Also, there will always be residents who find this temperature range either too hot or too cool, however we must use this range, since it is suitable for the majority.
